Suggested Creative Homework Projects

Challenge: How many can you complete?

- Create a recipe for what makes a great superhero. What would you need? What steps would you include in order to create the superhero? Do you have any handy hints or warnings to go alongside your recipe?
- Design a medal or trophy for someone who is a hero to you. Explore existing trophies and medals to see which inspire you. Put these ideas together to create your design. Can you bring your design to life by making it? You can be as creative as you like!
- Research a significant person from the past who you think is a hero. Once you have gathered your facts and information consider how you could present these for others so they can discover more about your chosen historical hero.
- Become a reporter for the day and create a news report about an event that has happened where a hero or heroes have been involved. These could be fictional or real life superheroes.
- Design an outfit for a superhero considering the materials you would choose based on their properties and explain why these materials are the most suitable for the job.
